## Proposal for Sponsoring 2009 District Convention

**Sandra Williams, LTG Div 37, (North Dallas) and husband Dennis PLTG were contacted by district:**

- **Suggested that Div.'s 37, 39, and 2 host 2008 or 2009 Convention at the Adams Mark hotel in Dallas.**
- **Our discussions suggested that 2008 competition would not allow time for good proposals and presentations. We agreed that 2009 allowed sufficient time for good planning.**
- **We recognized that clubs would need to make commitments to help. An early decision at June Division Council meetings would substantially enhance our ability to conduct planning and better compete with other applicants.**

### **Time Frame for 2009 District Convention:**

- **2 ½ years prior to Aug 2009: Determine local interest and get commitments from clubs and community**
- **Prior to May 2007: File application with District. Must present to board.**
- **Present to Aug 2007 TO Convention (reserve booth space): Campaign for delegate vote**
